Connecticut-based NFW introduces a new diver watch, the ViperFish. This timepiece measures 48 mm, is made of steel and features a screw-down crown with screw-in caseback. It's water resistant up to 1,000 feet and offered in a choice of either an automatic Miyota movement or a Miyota quartz chronograph movement. The wristwatch comes with both a black strap and a steel bracelet that you can change with the hex drivers included in your purchase. Estimated retail: \$800.

Greek Classic

d.freemont introduces The Santorini, a timepiece directly inspired by Greek culture of the Hellenistic age and the geography of the Santorini Islands. Located in the eastern Mediterranean Sea, these islands are known for their beautiful landscapes and pristine sunsets. The color scheme of the dial uses hues of gold and violet to resemble the island's sunsets. The case is hardened through a unique process to give the stainless steel a more antique look to enhance the Classic Greek inspiration. This manual-wind timepiece measures 42 mm in diameter and sports a sapphire crystal. Only 100 watches are being made by d.freemont and a personalized case back is an option that can make this watch even more special. This timepiece is complete with an Italian leather strap of your choice; yellow, light brown or dark brown. Price: \$720.

Blue Angles

The Telson collection by Serket is a perfect balance of attitude, masculinity and vogue. The brushed and polished stainless steel case measures in at 48 mm and is accompanied by a domed sapphire crystal and exhibition black dial background. All watches in the Telson collection have an ETA Swiss 6497 manual-wind movement and are water resistant up to 100 meters. The bold accents on the dial add some intrepid detail and are available in white, yellow and blue. To finish off the look, a black leather strap with stainless steel buckles adds a simple touch without overpowering the timepiece. Price: \$1,250.
